What is Homebound Service?

Homebound Service at the Monroe County Public Library is a personalized delivery of library materials to persons confined to their homes due to:

- Physical disability,
- Extended illness, or
- Significant transportation problems.

Items are selected based on patron requests and preferences, and are delivered once a month. This service is free to Monroe County residents.
